Essays

1) A 500-word essay on one of the following two topics:

- a) Write on the following quote by Mahatma Gandhi: "I want the cultures of all the lands to be blown about my house as freely as possible. But I refuse to be blown off my feet by any."
- b) How this experience will help shape me as a global citizen, and how I hope to apply this experience to my life once I return to the US.

2) A 250-word essay on the following topics:

- a) The person I most admire and why
- b) A person who has had a major influence in my life

3) A letter from a parent or guardian addressing how you will benefit from this scholarship.
