MEDICAL RELEASE AND AUTHORISATION

We, the parents/legal guardians of the student, hereby grant Student Exchange Australia, its directors and employees, coordinators and agents, successors and assigns the representatives of any school in which the student is placed, and the host parent or parents with whom the student is living at any time during the student's participation in the exchange program, [each of whom are hereby called 'the authorised persons'] full authority to place the student in hospital or like institution for the purpose of medical treatment and to consent to the administration of medical treatment for the student by any legally qualified medical practitioner, or by any qualified legal paramedical practitioner when administered under the direction or referral of a legally qualified medical practitioner. We agree to pay any cost or expense incurred in the administration of any such treatment for the student to the extent that the cost of such treatment is not covered or reimbursed by the student's medical health insurer. Authority is also given by us for any of the authorised persons to consent on our behalf to the administration of any medical, surgical or like treatment upon the student which is deemed necessary by any medical practitioner under whose care the student has been placed. We also authorise the authorised persons to return the student to the student's country of origin at our cost if such action is recommended by the student's treating practitioner. We confirm that, at the time of signing this document, the student enjoys good health and that the student's health record enclosed herewith is true and complete. We also consent to the student engaging in any physical or sporting activity whilst in Australia and understand that the program administrator may seek further written approval for the student to participate in hazardous activities. This authorisation shall be valid for the entire duration of the student's participation in the program.

LIABILITY RELEASE

We, the undersigned parents or legal guardians of a student in a program organised and directed by Student Exchange Australia on behalf of ourselves and our successors or legal representatives, renounce herewith all actions or claims that we or the student may otherwise have against Student Exchange Australia, its directors, employees, coordinators, agents, successors and assigns and the teachers and schools where the student may be assigned, or any person involved in the program, and that may arise due to injury, damage, sickness, accident, delay, unusual circumstances or expenses due to strikes, war, atmospheric conditions, quarantine, government restrictions or regulations, or those derived from acts or omission by airlines, companies, railroads, buses, transportation in general, hotels, restaurants or any other service given by companies, individuals or anyone related with the aforementioned. We understand that the student will be subject to the authorities and teachers of the school where he/she may be assigned and that he/she will have to follow the rules given by the family with whom he/she may live. We also understand that the administrators of the exchange program reserve the right to terminate the participation in the program at any time of any student who breaches the program rules or whose conduct is considered by the program administrator to be detrimental or incompatible with the interest and objectives of the program. If this decision is made, we agree that neither the student nor ourselves will have any right to any refunds or to claim any compensation or damages from Student Exchange Australia or its successors or assigns for any loss or expense we or the student may suffer or incur whether arising directly or indirectly from such termination. We accept the right of the program administrators to cancel, change or substitute any part of the program where they consider such cancellation, change or substitution necessary or desirable. We understand that should the program administrators in their discretion move or re-locate the student for any reason which is the responsibility of the student, the cost of transportation and all other necessary expenses incurred as a result of or arising from that move shall be then payable by us. We guarantee that, although we may maintain in the future a friendly relationship with the school, local coordinators, and family or families, with whom we may establish contact through Student Exchange Australia or its employees, we shall not make use of this knowledge to send in the future, directly or indirectly, students, relatives or friends to the said school, local coordinators, or families, unless it is through Student Exchange Australia. We also grant Student Exchange Australia and its successors and assigns permission to use in the future any photographic, text or any other type of material in which the student may appear, for promotion or publicity of the organisation's programs. We acknowledge that the student has agreed to accept and uphold the program rules and the standards of conduct set by Student Exchange Australia, the school where he/she may be assigned, and the family or families with whom he/she may live, for the duration of the program. We also understand that the student must maintain friendly and respectful relations with his/her teachers and classmates and, especially, with all the members of the family with whom he/she may be living, and to accept the rules of conduct imposed by that family. The student must participate in the family life as much as possible, try his/her best to adjust to the normal system of family life within that family and treat all the members of the family with due care and respect. We further agree that the participation of the student in the program may be terminated and the student returned to his/her country of origin at our expense at any time should the student fail to comply with these requirements.

RULES OF THE STUDENT EXCHANGE AUSTRALIA PROGRAM

While in Australia, students must abide by the rules of the program. A student who does not comply with the program rules may have his or her participation in the program terminated and the student may be sent home to their home country at their own expense. While in Australia, students must obey all the laws of the Australian government, including laws covering immigration status requirements, all State and Local Government laws, as well as the rules set by the school in which the student is placed, the host family and the program administrator.

Without limiting the general requirement as set out above we remind students that they must strictly comply for the duration of their program with the following rules:

1. Drinking alcohol is prohibited, except in the company of the host family and with their consent.
2. Possession and/or use of non-prescription drugs is prohibited.
3. Driving of any motorised vehicles is prohibited, except when supervised by legally qualified instructors as part of the student's school program.
4. Complying with all host family rules, including curfews, is obligatory.
5. Complying with all school rules, and maintaining pass or better grades is required.
6. Students must return to their home country by the last day of the program.
7. Without the authorisation of a correctly signed and submitted Travel Release, independent travel by students other than day to day travel within the immediate locality of their placement is not permitted during the program. This includes the period between the end of the last school term and the conclusion of the exchange program.
8. Students must demonstrate genuine effort to assimilate into their host family.
9. Students must not be convicted of any breach of Australian government or State government laws, and students must not have any charge of such alleged breach found proved even if no conviction is recorded by the courts.
10. Students suspected of suffering from an eating disorder are obliged to undergo a professional medical assessment and agree to the results being shared with Student Exchange Australia. If found to be suffering from an eating disorder, students will be returned home at the first opportunity for treatment.

I, the student, have read and understood all of the above rules. I agree to obey these rules and I understand that if I disobey them, my participation in the program may be terminated and I may be sent to my home country at my parents' expense.
