



News from Seville International Business and Culture Program October 1-7, 2007

El 1 de octubre de 1946 en la ciudad alemana de Nüremberg y tras 216 sesiones, un Tribunal Militar Internacional dictaba sentencia contra algunos de los altos mandos más sanguinarios del Partido Nazi, sentando las bases del Derecho Penal Internacional. Acusados de crímenes de guerra, contra la paz y la humanidad y de conspiración, doce militares fueron condenados a muerte y tres a cadena perpetua, sólo Goering escaparía a la horca gracias al suicidio. Pese a los intentos para que estos criminales no salieran impunes, muchos conseguirían evadir a la Justicia gracias a asociaciones como Odessa, en la que se daba cobertura a antiguos miembros de las SS en países de Latinoamérica como Argentina, Chile o Paraguay. El más famoso de estos huidos sería Menguele, "el ángel de la muerte". No sólo este tipo de organizaciones ayudaron a miembros del Partido Nazi, también lo hicieron países como EEUU. A través de operaciones secretas como la "Paperclip" más de 1500 científicos nazis llegarían a Norteamérica para colaborar con el Pentágono y la Agencia Espacial. Von Braun, Rudolph, Debus o Strughold formarían parte o dirigirían programas como el que acabaría con el lanzamiento del Saturno V y la llegada a la Luna. La Segunda Guerra Mundial quedaba muy lejos y el nuevo enemigo a abatir no eran ya las potencias del Eje sino la otrora aliada URSS. La labor de supervivientes de campos de concentración como Simon Wiesenthal, fundador del centro de documentación judío, y pese a las trabas marcadas por la nueva situación internacional, llevaría a la "caza" de personajes como Eichmann, organizador de la deportación y exterminio masivo de judíos, o Silberbauer, el hombre que detuvo a Ana Frank. **Elena García, Coordinadora de Actividades**
