#### **Adding/Dropping Classes**

The Add/Drop period for your classes at the UPO ends on Friday, February 1st. If you have doubts about whether you will receive credit for a class, you should contact your academic advisor in the States- it is your home school advisor who determines whether or not you will receive credit for a class.

#### **Taking Classes in Spanish**

If you test into the Advanced I Spanish level, you should DEFINITELY take at least 1 class in Spanish (in addition to your grammar class)...take all of your classes in Spanish if you like! Students that have taken content classes in Spanish find it very rewarding and end up doing very well. Although you will be challenged, Spanish content classes are geared toward second-language learners. Taking a class in Spanish is an excellent way to improve your written and spoken Spanish.
