

## Teach in Thailand—Special June 2012 Program

Many spring graduates are prevented from participating in the May term of the Teach in Thailand program because their graduation schedules overlap with the beginning of the program. CIEE is pleased to announce a special departure in June 2012 for qualified individuals who are unable to attend the orientation in May due to their spring 2012 graduations.

### Am I eligible for the June departure?

- The June departure is reserved for applicants who are graduating in spring 2012 and will not have their Bachelor's degrees in time for the start of regular orientation. All applicants who will have their diplomas prior to April 30<sup>th</sup> will be considered for the May program.
- Only candidates who can demonstrate that they will receive their physical college diploma by June 1, 2012 will be considered.
- Applicants participating in the June program must commit to a full academic year (2 semesters).

### How do I apply for the June program?

If you meet the qualifications for the June departure, please create an application for the May 2012 Teach in Thailand program. In lieu of your diploma, you may present CIEE with an official letter from your university stating your graduation date and the date you will receive a physical copy of your diploma. Additionally, when submitting this letter please indicate to CIEE that you intend to apply for the June program.

### How competitive is the June program?

There are a limited number of positions available beginnings in June. Applicants will be accepted on a rolling basis, and CIEE will close the application process when the program reaches capacity.

Due to the small program size, CIEE will be unable to place friends/couples together in June. If you intend on teaching in Thailand with a friend and cannot start in May, we recommend creating an application for the October 2012 program.
