- Journey up a steep river gorge to Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage Site once known as the "city of three cultures" – a place where Christians, Muslims, and Jews coexisted in peace.
- In Segovia, you'll visit an ancient Roman city, touring the aqueduct, a fairytale-style castle, and Romanesque churches in the Old Town.
- View graffiti art, wall murals, and street performances – all part of Madrid's vibrant urban art scene.
- Bike on cobblestone walkways along the Manzanares River and catch great views of Madrid's historic bridges and buildings.
