After our hiring event in Sofia, we will go to Skopje, the capital of Macedonia, where one can grab a meal in the Old Bazaar and visit the Mother Teresa Memorial House. The trip will wrap up in Croatia's capital, Zagreb, which is rich in colorful murals by local artists, pop-up markets, and food stalls.
