Job Description:

The Front of the House positions includes serving food, bussing tables, greeting and seating guests, and cashier/pastry counter. Our program will be a combination of all the above. A friendly, customer service personality is necessary for these positions. The cashiering and serving jobs require the ability to multi-task, to consolidate movements and have great money management skills. Hosting requires excellent speaking and communication skills, as well as the ability to stay positive and calm when busy.

When cashiering, you will be expected to promptly greet guests at the pastry counter, package pastries, get and slice loaves of bread, and make beverages for servers and customers. You will need to learn how to use the point of sale system to charge guests, take payments and make change. All of these should be done with a smile and a pleasing demeanor.

When serving tables, you will be expected to promptly greet your customers. You will learn to use the point of sale handheld device to accurately take food and drink orders and have excellent menu knowledge in order to answer any guest questions. You will need to move quickly to make and/or get guest drinks to the table. You are responsible for delivering food to tables throughout the restaurant, including those not in your section, as Cornerstone utilizes a teamwork system that requires all servers to take food from the Expeditors. You should check up on your guests, making sure their food order arrived properly and tastes great. As a server, you are in charge of your own money and should be good at handling and counting money. All of these tasks need to be done with a positive attitude and the Cornerstone smile

As a host, you are the first person to be seen by guests. As such, it is necessary for our hosts to have a great smile, welcoming air and a general happy vibe. You will greet guests, manage the waitlist, and follow a server rotation seating process. The hosts get busy and you must be able to quickly and efficiently enter names and phone numbers into the waitlist program and properly quote wait times. Great hosts learn the regular customers' names and look forward to seeing them come in.

Server shifts vary from 6:30am - 4:30am, 7:30am - 4:30am, and 8am - 5pm. -Hours worked per week will average between 35 and 40

Training wages are \$9.00 per hour no tips. Menus will be sent out in the pre arrival package for preparation of knowledge test. The student will be expected to learn the menu prior to their arrival.

Training requirements:

Anyone over 19 that will be serving alcoholic beverages will need to become Alcohol Server Certified. Cornerstone Bakery Cafe will train new employees by pairing them with a Cashier, Server or Host trainer that will show them all the requirements of the job position. Each day, they will take over more responsibilities of the job position. When the new employee performs to the expectation of said job, they will get placed on the schedule. The participant will be best prepared when they arrive with the menu knowledge test complete and already having their alcohol certification.

Uniform Policy:

Cornerstone Bakery requires the Front of the House employees to wear a pressed white, long sleeve, button down shirt. Along with an apron. These are provided by Cornerstone for the employees for a \$1.25 fee each day they are scheduled. This fee will be taken out of each FOH employee's paycheck every week. Participant will be required to bring their own black pants, and non-slip shoes. Non-slip shoes can be purchased and deducted from the paychecks.

Ruidoso, New Mexico is in the Southern part of New Mexico. The closest International Airport is in Roswell, New Mexico (ROW). The airline is American Airlines (American Eagle). This airport is 1 hour and 15 minutes from our location. This is a very small airport and is extremely easy to navigate. No cost transportation from this airport is available. This transportation will need to be set up directly with steven@CornerstoneBakeryCafe.com.

The next two larger airports are in Albuquerque, NM and El Paso, Texas. These airports are usually less expensive to fly to; however, they add additional transportation costs to finish the commute. These airports are much larger international airports with many providers. These two locations are about 3 hours from our location.

The round trip bus fare from Albuquerque, NM is as low as \$125.00 - \$350.00.

The round trip bus fare from El Paso, TX is between \$125.00 - \$350.00.
