Sample Itinerary

Program Theme: Health, Wellness, and Inequality in South Africa

Day 1	Experience an onsite orientation & city tour.
Day 2	Study food security issues and the role of South African history on community health by visiting a community garden.
Day 3	Learn about pioneering heart transplants with a visit to the teaching hospital at the University of Cape Town.
Day 4	Get an introduction to medicinal plants and eat a meal of foraged foods. Visit the world-famous Penguin Colony.
Day 5	Receive a lesson on health and wellness as practiced by the San people by visiting the Khwattu Nature Reserve (the San Heritage Center).
Day 6	Learn about Stellenbosch ecosystems at the Greenpop Helderberg Hospital Garden.
Day 7	Meet youth mental health practitioners on a visit to a healthcare provider in a marginalized community. Do a reflection session & give farewells to classmates.
