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Study Abroad Grant Opportunity for Your Students

We hope a student from your institution will be part of the 2027 SCAN Design Foundation Environmental Sustainability Internship cohort. However, even if they are not selected, all eligible applicants will receive a \$1,500 grant that can be applied toward any CIEE summer or semester program through 2028. Pell-eligible students may also receive the GAIN Travel Grant, which provides up to \$500 toward airfare.

Below is a sample of other CIEE programs that give students the opportunity to further their studies while gaining meaningful experience in environmental sustainability.





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Ecology + Sustainability

MÉRIDA, MEXICO | \$9,950



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Mérida while exploring ecosystem conservation, environmental policy, and climate resilience. This program provides insight into Mexico's unique environmental challenges and the rich biodiversity of the Yucatán region.

SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO | \$10,950



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in San Juan while exploring coral reef restoration, renewable energy initiatives, and conservation policy. This program provides insight into Puerto Rico's unique environmental challenges and sustainability efforts across the Caribbean.

MONTEVERDE, COSTA RICA | \$13,950



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Monteverde while exploring biodiversity conservation, regenerative agriculture, and ecosystem resilience. This program provides insight into Costa Rica's pioneering sustainability initiatives and the unique ecology of its cloud forest environments.

COPENHAGEN, DENMARK | \$15,500



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Copenhagen while exploring carbon-neutral technology, marine ecosystems, and sustainable urban systems. This program provides insight into Denmark's approach to ecological resilience and environmental innovation.



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ATHENS, GREECE | \$17,450



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Athens while exploring renewable energy, sustainable agriculture, and environmental policy. This program provides insight into real-world ecological challenges and sustainability initiatives shaping the Mediterranean region.

PALMA DE MALLORCA, SPAIN | \$17,450



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Palma de Mallorca while exploring marine ecology, sustainable tourism, and ecosystem restoration. This program provides insight into Spain's leading approaches to coastal conservation and environmental resilience.

GABORONE, BOTSWANA | \$17,950



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Gaborone while exploring biodiversity conservation, ecosystem resilience, and sustainable development. This program provides insight into environmental challenges and sustainability practices across Botswana and southern Africa.



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AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND | \$19,950



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Auckland while exploring biodiversity, marine ecosystems, and renewable energy. This program provides insight into sustainability practices and environmental challenges unique to New Zealand and the Pacific region.

LISBON, PORTUGAL | \$19,950



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Lisbon while exploring marine conservation, biodiversity restoration, and environmental policy. This program provides insight into Portugal's innovative sustainability initiatives and environmental challenges.

CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA | \$21,450



Students can study Ecology + Sustainability in Cape Town while exploring marine conservation, ecosystem resilience, and green planning. This program provides insight into South Africa's unique environmental challenges and sustainability initiatives.
