A FULLY FUNDED SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM FOR DIVERSE STUDENT LEADERS

The 2027 Douglass-O'Connell Global Internship marks its 11th year of preparing student leaders for global careers through cultural exchange and hands-on professional experience. Thirteen (13) students will be selected for an eight-week summer internship in Dublin, Ireland, where they will gain real-world work experience while deepening their understanding of Irish history and culture.

From June 14 to August 7, 2027, interns will:

- Attend lectures on the history of social change in Ireland
- Participate in networking and extracurricular activities
- Intern with a host company aligned with their skills and career goals

**Applications will be accepted until January 8, 2027.
The 2027 cohort will be announced in late January.**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Douglass-O'Connell Global Internship Applicants Must:

- Be a current undergraduate freshman, sophomore, or junior from an accredited institution
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or permanent resident
- Be Pell Grant-eligible
- Submit a complete application no later than January 8, 2027
